Esther 9

Esther 9.1-10

- V 1-2 Adar our month of March
 - **-What happened on the appointed day?** The Jews made a good defense of themselves
- <u>V 3</u> Even the government officials assisted the Jews (because the dread of Mordecai had fallen on them)
- <u>V 4</u> Mordecai was very powerful
- **V** 5 Many people were killed by the Jews
- \underline{V} 6 How many were killed at the citadel in Susa? 500
- <u>V 7-10</u> Who else was killed (with the sword)? The 10 sons of Haman
 - -But the Jews did not plunder property

Esther 9.11-19

- <u>V 11</u> The destruction was reported to the king
- <u>V 12</u> The king asked Ether if there was anything else he could do for her
- <u>V 13</u> Requests of Esther? For another day to kill the enemies of the Jews in Susa and to let the 10 sons of Haman be hanged
 - -The 10 sons were killed with the sword in v 6-10, but Esther had their dead bodies hung before the city (a lesson in the power of God against arrogant people)
- <u>V 15</u> Another 300 people were killed
- \underline{V} 16 75,000 were killed elsewhere in the kingdom
- $\underline{V 17-19}$ The day of death: 13th day of Adar (v I) the 14th day for the Jews in Susa -Rural Jews rested on the 14th day

Esther 9.20-30

- <u>V 20-21</u> **What did Mordecai set aside for celebration?** The 14th and 15th days of the month Adar
- <u>V 22</u> **How would they celebrate?** By sending food and gifts to their fellow Jews
- <u>V 23-24</u> What did lots have to do with it? Haman had cast lots to determine the best day on

which to kill the Jews (see *Esther 3.7* – the casting of the lot ("Pur" in Hebrew)

<u>V 25-26</u> – Name for this feast? "Lots" or in Hebrew "Purim" (the plural form)

 $\underline{\mathbf{V}}$ 27-28 – To be celebrated every year

<u>V 29-30</u> – A feast for all generations of Jews
