# Genesis 14

### **Genesis 14.1-12**

- <u>V 1</u> Four kings began a vicious attack on the area where Abraham and Lot were living -Four kings: Amraphel, Arioch, Chedorlaomer, and Tidal, all from the north area (later Babylon, Persia, etc.)
- <u>V 2</u> Who did they attack? Sodom and Gomorrah and several nearby cities
  - -Five kings in the area made an alliance
- <u>V 3</u> Location: In area of Salt Sea (Dead Sea)
  - -Where is the Dead Sea?
  - -Why called that?
  - -Song: "There Is a Sea," #654, Praise for the Lord
  - -Dead Sea surface is 1292 feet below medium sea level 6 miles long; 9½ miles wide
  - -5 times salter than ordinary ocean water

Note: It is believed that Sodom and Gomorrah are buried in south end of the Dead Sea

- $\underline{V4}$  How long was the area in control of four kings? Twelve years
- <u>V 5-7</u> Various conquest of Chedorlaomer
- <u>V 8</u> Five kings of Sodom, etc., came out for battle
- **V9** Four kings against five kings
- **V 10** The armies of Sodom and Gomorrah lost
  - -What was one cause for the disaster? Tar pits
  - -They fell in (much oil in Middle East today)
- <u>V 11</u> Much "looting" the four kings of the north took many captives
- <u>V 12</u> Among their captives? Lot

## Genesis 14.13-16

- V13 Who told Abraham? A "fugitive" escapee
  - -vs. 13 1st use of term Hebrew term used to designate descendants of Abraham
  - -Possible meaning: one from other side (of river)
  - -vs. 13 Abraham had his own allies
- V 14 What was Abraham's reaction? Immediately got his men ready to go and rescue Lot
  - **-How many men?** 318 Indicates the wealth of Abraham
  - -Dan about 100 miles North of Hebron

- V 15 How did Abraham surprise the enemy? Divided his men and attacked at night
  - -Also, pursued them North of Damascus (Syria today)
  - -Abraham, therefore, was very successful in this battle

<u>V 16</u> – **Result?** Everyone and everything was returned

# **Genesis 14.17-24**

<u>V 17</u> – Reaction when Abraham got back? Everyone was grateful to him (even the king of Sodom)

- <u>V 18</u> Who else met him? Melchizedek the priest and king of Salem (later Jerusalem)
  - -Salem from Shalom = Hebrew for "peace"
  - -Melchizedek was a priest of the God Most High

#### Melchizedek:

Psalm 110.4 – Jesus a priest to Melchizedek (Aaron, from Levi)

Hebrews 5.6,10

Hebrews 6.20

Hebrews 7.1-21

- <u>V 19</u> What did Melchizedek do? Blessed Abraham
- <u>V 20</u> Who gave Abraham the victory, according to Melchizedek? God

-What was Abraham's response? Gave 10% to Melchizedek

- <u>V 21</u> What did king of Sodom want to do? Keep the people Abraham rescued and give all the money, etc., to Abraham
- <u>V 22-23</u> **Abraham's reaction?** No deal you keep all that is yours
  - **-Why?** Abraham didn't want to owe king of Sodom anything
  - -You give some people something, and for the rest of your life they bring it up to you "I let you ride my bicycle when you wanted to ..."
  - -Abraham: "not beholden to anyone"
- <u>V 24</u> What was the only reimbursement Abraham wanted? For food the men of Sodom had eaten
