Genesis 19

Genesis 19.1-11

- <u>V1</u> Two angels? Third being talking with Abraham
 - **-Where is Lot?** At the gate of the city
 - -Place of prominence maybe Lot was an official of city
 - -Legal affairs were often conducted at gate of city Ruth 4.1-12
 - -What was Lot's reaction to the two strangers? Great hospitality, lodging, etc.
- <u>V 2</u> Lot invited them to his house, washed their feet, etc.
 - -Reaction of two "men" (angels)? Wanted to spend night in city square
 - **-Why?** See *Genesis 18.21* to see for themselves
- <u>V 3</u> Lot's reaction? Urged them not to spend the night in square (too wicked)
 - -Apparently the two angels agreed to spend night inside Lot's house
- <u>V 4</u> What did people in town do? A small [riot] surrounded the house of Lot
- <u>V 5</u> The crowd was demanding that the two angels come out so that they could have sexual relations with them.
 - -The most evil scene in the Bible
- <u>V 6</u> What did Lot do? Tried to talk to them
 - -Why did he close the door behind him? So that angels could not hear him (a sad conversation)
- <u>V 7</u> Notice "my brothers" Indicates? Lot was considered one of them (close to them)
- <u>V 8</u> What did Lot do? Offered his two virgin daughters
 - -This indicates Lot's lack of moral strength
 - -Why did Lot want to protect two [men]? For sake of hospitality (verse 8)
- **V9 Reaction of crowd?** "Stand aside"
 - -What did they say about Lot? An "outsider"
 - -They almost broke the door down
- <u>V 10-11</u> What did two angels do? Struck townspeople with blindness
 - -Did it cause the mob to disperse? No they just couldn't find the door

Genesis 19.12-22

- <u>V 12</u> Message of angels to Lot? Get all your family together get them out of the city
- <u>V 13</u> Why leave the city? About to be destroyed
- <u>V 14</u> Who did Lot try to get to leave? Future sons-in-law

- **-Their reaction?** Thought he was kidding
- -Indicates that he did not have a reputation of being a righteous man
- <u>V 15</u> Early next morning (possibly *verse 14* was very late at night early morning)
 - -Message of angels? Get wife and daughters and run for your lives
- V 16 What did Lot do? Hesitated
 - **-Why?** Maybe he liked the city too much
 - **-What did the angels do?** Got them all by hand and led them out of the city
 - **-Why?** God had mercy on Lot
- <u>V 17</u> Instructions of angels? Don't look back; don't stay in the valley, but run to mountains
- V 18 How many righteous did Abraham think he could find in Sodom? Ten
 - **-How many actually left Sodom (righteous people)?** Four Lot, wife, two daughters
- <u>V 18-19</u> Request from Lot? Mountains were too far away to get to
- <u>V 20</u> Lot still didn't seem to realize how serious it was wanted just to go to next town
- $\underline{V21}$ Reply of angels? OK just make it to that town
- <u>V 22</u> Notice the sense of urgency like holding back huge wall of water, ready to break loose any second

Genesis 19.23-26

- V 23 Time of day? Sun has come up
- <u>V 24</u> The destruction of Sodom/Gomorrah began
- <u>V 25</u> Towns in immediate vicinity were also destroyed
- <u>V 26</u> What about Lot's wife? Looked back
 - -What happened to her? She turned into a pillar of salt
- Read Luke 17.28-33
 - **-Great Lessons?** Put hand to plow and don't look back
 - -Don't look back at your old way of life

Genesis 19.27-29

- <u>V 27</u> Abraham got up early went to place where he had "dealt" with God over destruction of Sodom
- <u>V 28</u> What did Abraham see? Smoke of burning of Sodom and Gomorrah

V 29 – Would Abraham have missed Lot? Yes

-It seems that God saved Lot (to some extent) because of righteousness of Abraham

Genesis 19.30-38 - A pitiful incident from life of Lot

<u>V 30</u> – Why did he live in a cave? Possibly afraid of people in Zoar (would blame him for destruction of Sodom, etc.)

-Remember: Lot had just lost his wife – maybe not yet back to normal

<u>V 31</u> – What did his daughters get worried about? No children and not married

<u>V 32</u> – Their plan? Get their father drunk and have sexual relations with him (to have children)

<u>V 33</u> – Older daughter did it first

<u>V 34-35</u> – Younger daughter the next night

<u>V 36</u> – Both daughters became pregnant

V 37 –"Moab" born to older daughter

<u>V 38</u> – Benammi (father of Ammonites) born to younger daughter
