Review of Rev. 9

- **-Fifth trumpet sounded?** Locusts came out of the pit (hell)
- -Appearance of the locusts?
- -Name of the ruler of hell? Apollyon (satire on Apollo)
- **-Sixth trumpet?** Huge army gathered at the Euphrates River (Persians) the Romans were terrified

Revelation 10.1-7

- -3 sets of symbols in Rev.: 7 seals, 7 trumpets, 7 bowls of wrath
- -Interlude between #6 and #7 seals? For the sealing of God's people
- -Interlude a period of warning for the people
- <u>V 1</u> Where was John? Still in prison on the island of Patmos
 - -Could this angel have been Christ?
 - -Notice v 6-7 the angel swears by Christ, so the angel is not Christ
 - -Description of the angel?
- Any similarities of the cloud and legs like pillar of fire in the Old Testament? See Exod.
 - 13.21-22 Pillar of cloud by day, and pillar of fire by night
 - -Rainbow? A reference to God's promise to Noah
- $\underline{V2}$ Little book The scroll of *Rev.* 5? No
 - -Describe the stance of this angel? A colossal figure: one foot on the sea, one on the land
 - -What would this signify? Size and might
- **V.3 What noise is made?** Sound like roar of lion
 - -Next noise? 7 peals of thunder
- <u>V 4</u> What did John start to do? Write down the words of peals of thunder
 - **-Thunder?** More words of warning to wicked Romans, but they still had not repented (*Rev.* 9.21)
 - -So more words would be useless
- <u>V 5</u> What is usually symbolized by the raising of the right hand? Swearing to tell the truth -Swore by ? Jesus
 - -Are we to swear today? See Matt. 5.33-37 Our word is to be trustworthy (without swearing)
- <u>V 6</u> Who had wanted things speeded up? Rev. 6 Fifth seal the Christian martyrs said, "How long...?"
 - -Therefore, no more delays nothing was standing in the way of final victory of Christ over the Roman Empire
 - -Attributes of God, according to v 6? Lives forever and ever, etc.
 - -People refused to repent for the trumpets #1-6
 - -Now God will bring his judgment on them

-The seventh trumpet prepares to sound (*Rev. 11.15*)

<u>V 7</u> – What is going to happen as the seventh trumpet sounds? God's plans will be fulfilled

Revelation 10.8-11

- **V8 Where had he heard the voice before?** *V4* from heaven
 - -Instructions now? Get the book
- $\underline{V 9-10}$ Bible? Makes the mouth sweet as honey
 - -See Psalm 119.103 and Jer. 15.16
 - -To "eat the book"? To digest it mentally
 - -Therefore, the preacher must know the Bible well, before he is able to preach properly
 - **-Bitter stomach?** The message is going to be harsh
 - **-The "little scroll"?** Prophecies leading up to the sounding of the 7th trumpet and *Rev*. 11.15

<u>V 11</u> – He must prophesy (*Rev. 11* is going to be very important)
